FR.TK. REFLECTIONS 12th SUNDAY YEAR A-2023. CALL TO COURAGEOUS WITNESSING-DO NOT BE AFRAID!.

Prophet Jeremiah in our first reading (Jer.20:10-13) had the very unpopular job of warning Gods people. They were supposed to keep His covenant (commandments) if God was to protect them from Babylonian. You can be assured they broke almost all, of them and never listened to the prophet, he became their enemy and they looked for his downfall by all means.

This is too happening in our present day society to followers of Christ in many places and countries whenever the people are cautioned of observing rules and regulations.

In our Gospel today(Mt.10:26-33) Jesus send the apostles after choosing them last Sunday he is giving them this unpopular job and mission of witnessing and spreading the gospel of the kingdom of God. He is telling them it is not going to be an easy task at all. Challenges ,trials, hatred, insults and persecution's will be inevitable. In the same note he is encouraging them they must not be afraid at all. How many people are ready to stand against what is happening in some countries, Most of the religious leaders are compromised and are allowing these the so called rulers to use the churches as flat forms to further their political aspirations.
