Jodi Leveque led the attendees in an opening prayer.

The minutes of the June 13, 2016 and September 12, 2016 meetings were approved.

Thanksgiving Dinner: St. A's will host the Second Annual Thanksgiving Day Dinner. Paul Obranovich has offered to cook the food and needs assistance with the event.

Council Retreat: The Pastoral Council retreat has been organized and is set for October 22<sup>nd</sup>. We will attend 8:45 Mass at St. A's and then drive up to the Monastery. Mark Brumley will lead with a presentation and it is expected to end at 2:30.

Church Renovation Committee: Gerry Cruz gave an update on the renovation. It will be done in two phases, first the outside and then the inside. Information is being gathered on paint colors. The shear wall is being brought into code compliance. The goal is to complete the outside by Thanksgiving. The Finance Committee approved \$450,000 for the exterior walls and roof repair (the first phase of the renovations). An audience member asked if the committee could put monthly updates on the status of the renovations in the bulletin.

Hospitality Sunday: The Pastoral Council is hosting Hospitality Sunday on December 4<sup>th</sup>. We need at least two people to commit to the 7:30, 9:00, and 10:30 Masses. Gerry Cruz and Jesse DeLuna will attend 7:30, Rosie Calabrese and Dan Capponi will attend the 9:00, and Lyn Gagetta, Jodi Leveque, and David Figueroa will attend the 10:30.

Angel Bazaar: Sister Peggy's Angel Bazaar will be held the weekend of November 12/13. All are encouraged to attend.

Pastor's Report: Father Donahue just returned from a pilgrimage to Italy where they were able to see the Pope and had a wonderful experience.

All the contracts have been signed and the renovation work is moving forward.

The Finance Committee is creating a parish budget. It is expected to take two to three years to see the cost of running the parish.

Father Thomas will return to Napa at the beginning of November. We would like to plan a party for him as he will return to St. John's parish as his new assignment. Father Donahue will confirm his return date and see what type of event he would prefer.
