## FR.TK, REFLECTIONS SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT 2024. THE MOUNTAIN EXPERIENCE:

Last Sunday, the gospel talked of the wildness/Desert experience, where Jesus spent forty days and nights. We could term this as **call of the Desert of** *prayer*, *fasting and self giving*. Todays readings are taking us to another call of *promise and union with God in the mountain*.

In the first reading we see a great man of faith and trust in God in the person of Abram. He is asked by God to leave his own home, clan and land to unknown destination. Is this not an expression of great faith? detaching himself from known and attaching himself to unknown voice! No wonder he is called the the father of faith and indeed he is.

Time and again God is calling you and me to renounce vices of pride, selfishness, attachment of materialism and hurting others. He is calling us to leave our Haran, comfort familiar zone of good time and pleasure, set aside our plans and listen to that voice of His plan. It is a call of trust and confidence in God. what is your response to this call.

In the Gospel, Jesus knowing what was going to happen to him as he proceeds torwards Jerusalem, had this great moment of call of the mountain. He withdraw to the mountain (Tabor). He had a moment of detaching himself from the world and attach himself to his father. He prayed for strength for his journey to Calvary and enlightenment. He poured his soul to the father and he had a marvelous experience. The fathers voice assured him, His appearance changed, his face shone like sun and his

clothes became bright(Mk.9:3). This is what we call <u>Transfiguration, His heart and spirit are strengthened and he is</u> <u>ready to face the next mountain of Calvary.</u>

His personality and mission is defined and confirmed by His father this is my son, the beloved, my listen to him(mk.9:7). The apostles who were with Him saw a new Jesus on the mountain, a preview of His glory beyond the cross. Moses and Elijah offered him assurance by the virtue of their presence. We are called today to listen to that voice of the father despite many voices distracting us in the world. which one are you going to listen today as we enter the second Sunday of Lent?

We all have moments in our Christian way of life.we have good,bad and challenges moments as followers of Christ?

Don't we all face disappointments and challenges in life especially in our current society with all the scandals,social, doctrinal and financial issues facing our world and the church.we need that mountain experience,our (Tabor) so as to get strength especially those moments we are low, we need that union with God.

Martin Luther King when he was tired, exhausted and despairing throw himself on his kneels before God and said:

Lord I have taken a stand for what I believe is right, but now am afraid. The people are looking for me for leadership. If I stand before them without strength and courage, they will too falter. But am at the end of my powers, I have nothing left. I can't face it alone. We need God to continue the struggle.
