A note from the Pastor:

Recent Upgrades to Church Sound System

I hope that you have noticed the upgrades made on March 5 and 6 to our church sound system. These include replacing the wireless microphone system that had been glitching for a while. The ambo microphone was also replaced--requiring a major rewire of that part of the system, which was more than 30 years old. By the time you read this, I hope we will also have a new altar microphone (one of its parts is on backorder as I write).

A huge note of thanks goes out to Michael Nivens, a parish volunteer who over many months did a lot of research on what we needed, what was available, and who could do the work for our church. He also put extensive labor into improving the functionality of our assisted-listening system. THANK YOU, MICHAEL! God bless you for your commitment and perseverance.

Of course, these upgrades do not come cheap. The whole project is costing the parish in the region of \$20,000 (including parts and labor). Of this we already had about \$7,500 in project-specific donations. Now that the work has been done, please make a contribution to this upgrade. Any contribution would be extremely helpful to our parish "bottom line". Checks may be made out to "St. Apollinaris Catholic Church" with "Sound System" on the memo line. Such donations will be used only toward paying for the church sound system.

FAITH FORMATION

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM

Our St. Apollinaris Religious Education Program provides preparation for sacraments and assists parish families with their child/ren's faith formation. Our program is designed to support the parents of baptized children who are not attending Catholic school (or who are new to Catholic school and in need of classes for

First Holy Communion Preparation

Our two year First Holy Communion program is for children who are in at least 1st grade. Preparation lasts two years and children receive the sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion in the second year of the program.

Continuing Education Program

Our Continuing Education program is for children in 3-5th grade that have already made their First Holy Communion.

Confirmation Preparation

To enroll in the 1st year of the Confirmation program children must be in at least 6th grade. Preparation for Confirmation lasts two years and children receive the sacrament of Confirmation in the second year of the program. Anyone over the age of 18 enrolls in our St. Apollinaris Adult Confirmation Program.

All Preparation Classes require attendance for two (2) consecutive years to receive sacraments.


VBS is Coming!!


