

FR.TK.REFLECTIONS TRINITY SUNDAY YEAR B -2024:

UNDIVIDED UNITY OF LOVE:

The past few weeks we have had great themes in our faith which needs a lot of considerations. We had **Resurrection, Ascension** and **Pentecost**, today we have the great mystery of our faith, the **Most Holy Trinity**. Next Sunday we will celebrate the **Body and blood of christ (The Corpus Christi)**. These are great signs in the Catholic faith which makes it **unique, peculiar and special**. Theologically they are called **Dogmas of faith (the truths of faith)**.

Holy Trinity is the greatest mystery we have in our faith, it can only be understood through **faith not by scientific investigations at all**. trinity,thus joining **life of love,communion and unity**.We are commissioned today by the Lord to take that missionaries activity of teaching and **making people become that part by Baptism**.

The mystery of the Trinity will have a meaning for us in our Christian life,if we put into practice,that unity based on unity and know our roles as Catholics following the role model of the the Trinity which is so clear that **God the father is the creator,God the son is the redeemer and God the spirit is our helper thus working hand in hand for our salvation**.
