FR.TK.REFLECTIONS SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER B-2024: LOVE ONE ANOTHER:

Last Sunday we dealt with the vine and the branches, it led us to our connection and relationship with Jesus and one another. we were told to be close to one another hence we need each other.

In the first reading (Act.10:25-48), we see the great work of the Apostles in evangelization extending the wing of faith to even the Gentles. They went beyond the Jewish territories and boundaries to reach out to other people. The gospel of love is witnessed through proclamation of the word of Peter to Cornelius and his companion who had received the Holy Spirit even before Baptism. what a wonder for the Holy Spirit to be with these upcoming Christians and for the gospel to b be proclaimed to all people.
