Our St. Apollinaris Religious Education Program

provides preparation for sacraments and assists parish families with their child/ren's faith formation. Our program is designed to support the parents of baptized children who are not attending Catholic school (or who are new to Catholic school and in need of classes for Sacramental Preparation).

First Holy Communion Preparation

Our two year First Holy Communion program is for children who are in at least 1st grade. Preparation lasts two years and children receive the sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion during the second year of the program.

Preparation requires attendance for two (2) consecutive years to receive sacraments.
