## **FOOD FOR THE JOURNEY:**

We don't have permanent residence in this world, we are not citizen of this world, we are just passing through. Our permanent abode is heaven. we are on transits and our journey here can be tricky and challenging with hardships, sickness and confrontations of different magnitude. We must be always prepared as we journey in faith. we need food for our bodies and spiritual food for our souls.

In our first reading(lkgs 19;4-8), the great prophet Elijah is facing such hardship of his ministry and challenge even of his life as he championed the worship of one true God as opposed to worship of Baals with the false prophets.we clearly see his humanity on trial as he escapes the wrath of the wicked Queen Jezebel who was longing for the prophets life to revenge. Elijah escapes for his life in the desert, broken hearted and dispirited. He couldn't take more, he prayed that he would die. It is in such situation of desperation that he was woken up by the Angel, given food and water for the journey. He was fed with the heavenly bread.we all face such situations on our journey here in the world, we we feel discounted, disillusioned by situation of life, we feel alone, we feel God is not on our side. Don't we all need food and encouragement in such situation? Don't we need a short, encouraging word of support like Elijah\*Get up and eat for the journey is long\*we would like to hear that from a friend can you be that Angel to someone?

In the gospel(Jn 6:41-51) after Jesus had done the miracle of multiplication of the bread and fish, and feed the gathered crowd, he took the opportunity of teaching them that he is **the living bread** 

which came down from heaven. Obviously they had not yet opened their eyes of believing in him, they saw the bread and fish but Christ told more than that. Jesus told them and fed them, is he not doing the same to us at every mass? He is teaching us with his word from the scripture and feeding us with Eucharist,\*This is my body, this is my blood\*. He addressed their immediate hunger and told them through feeding them.
