FR.TK.REFLECTIONS 27th SUNDAY YEAR -B-2024. THE INSTITUTION OF MARRIAGE:

The book of Genesis has two accounts of the institution marriage(Gen1:26-28) sees marriage as a means of procreation, while (Gen.2:18-21) sees it as means of meetings human companionship and complimenting man and woman, both are correct. The complimentary nature is so much stressed because God created them for each other. Man and woman will break all other ties and join in marriage. God saw that it was not good for man to stay alone (Gen.2:18) I will make a suitable partner for him. Due to this strength in this attraction and the need for partnership, therefore a man will leave his father and mother and cling to his wife and both becomes one flesh.

There are some truth about marriage in todays readings we should give a thought. We must understand the marriage is a unique relationship, we are all involved in different strong and weak, temporary and enduring relationship in our lifes, like king and his people, teacher and students, priests and parishioners, lawyer and client, Doctor and patience, yet among these many and other rerelatioship, the book of Genesisi singes out only one and traces it back to the very start of creation, that is the relationship of man and wife. was created by God himself hence very unique. It is older

than Israel and more ancient than the church. Marriage is not as a result of human convention, social or legislation as other relationships. Marriage of man and woman is inscribed by God himself nothing can replace or imitate. it is intended by God to be superior than other relationship hence the respect for marriage must be observed.
