## **ON STAND BY:**

Todays readings are indeed disturbing, filled with **cosmic collapse** and **signs of the end of times.** They tell of events like moon, sun stars **failing to give light, wars, terrorism, family conflicts, political instability and conflicts, earth quakes, fires etc.** Are all these not happens in our present day world? Might we be at the end of times? could this be it now? Todays events in the world and conflicts in different areas should lead us into the proper perspective of our readings today.
