ACTION NOT WORDS:

Pope Francis must be having very hard time in todays readings contrary to his recent short homilies of 7minutes and below. Already the priests and Catholics in Kenya have an issue with short homilies. Am a victim of my nieces during my vacation when I gave 15 mins homily not many were impressed with me.

Our first reading (Nehemiah 8:2-4,5-6,8-10) we have more than a Kenyan homily this one lasted for half a day! I would assure you in America and Europe he would have been left there alone with several emails to the pope! The main reason for such long homily is that the people had just returned from exile, finding the town and temple in ruins, no houses no nothing. They were divided, hostile and quarreling to each other. Not only the city and the walls of Jerusalem needed to be rebuild but the people had to be rebuilt as a community. Ezra had to take the responsibility and teach the people their common root and descend as chosen people hence they should stop fighting one another and rebuilt their destroyed city and the temple they need to take action not hating in words.. We all need such cautions in our present society where modern technology is taking the society by storm furthering things contrary to morality and faith very fast. We need the institution of the church to stand firm. The battle is there between the scripture and media and we are the battle field. The media and the society is fighting the church.we are the church we are under attack and we are the body of Christ.
