


Honoring Mary, Our Lady Queen of the Most Holy Rosary

All are welcome to join us in honoring Mary as we pray the rosary in procession outside on the monastery grounds ~~ or pray in the chapel for those who prefer not to walk ~~ Following the rosary, there will be a Crowning of Mary with Adoration & Benediction in the chapel. At the beginning of the Jubilee Year, the Pope opened a Holy Door in Saint Peter's Basilica in the Vatican. This door is usually sealed and only

opened during a Jubilee Year. Four other doors were also opened in Rome, three in other basilicas and one in a prison as a gesture of hope for prisoners. Jesus is the "way', the "door' and the "gate" that allows those who follow him to reach heaven. Pilgrims want to walk through the door into a sacred space because they have decided to follow and be guided by Jesus...
