### Where does my money go?

Every Sunday at Mass we take up a regular "plate" collection. Many of you also contribute to this weekly collection online or through your bank's bill-pay service. While we take up other collections during the course of the year, the contributions to the weekly collection are the main source of revenue for our ordinary parish operating expenses.

### Here's an overview of where your weekly contributions go:

- Priests' Salaries and Benefits
- Lay Staff Salary and Benefits (including office staff, religious education, music ministers)
- Insurance for our parish buildings and grounds
- Utilities (including electricity, gas, water, internet, phone)
- Liturgical expenses, such as hosts, wine, missalettes
- Equipment purchase and maintenance Bookkeeping services

Approximately 15% of this collection goes to the Diocese. This money pays for a number of services the parish uses on a regular basis but would have difficulty providing for itself. These services include human resources, legal representation, risk management, lay and clergy benefits coordination, and the financial oversight that the Bishop must exercise over parish under church law. (For example, our parish had a full financial audit by the Diocese just last month.) These diocesan services are separate from the ministries of the Diocese funded by the Annual Ministries Appeal.

Each year we develop a parish budget that is approved and overseen by our Parish Finance Council, under the leadership of Laura Wintz. As with everyone else today, rising costs for even the most essential services are a constant challenge. However, we work to make sure that the services our parishioners expect from their parish are provided in a manner that exemplifies good stewardship of the funds you have entrusted to us.

The "Budget" amount you see in the bulletin each weekend is based on what we need to pay our weekly, monthly, and annual bills. Generally speaking, we now come within our budget over the course of the year. For this we are extremely grateful to everyone who contributes to the weekly collection. However, as with any household or business, each year sees increased costs. Therefore, any increase that you could make to your regular contribution to the parish would be very helpful in keeping us current with paying for regular parish operations.

As always, thank you for your support of our parish.
