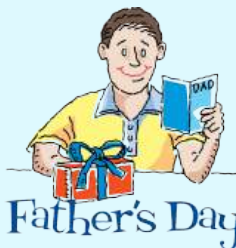

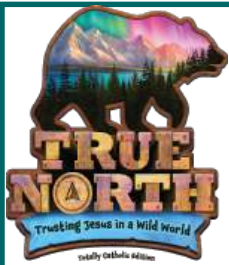

Summer is here! Scrip is sold in the school office during office hours and on Sundays from 8:00 am to noon in front of the school office.



The St Vincent de Paul Society at St Apollinaris provides food vouchers to those in need, who live in Napa, every Monday & Wednesday from 4-5pm. As costs have continued

to increase, we have found ourselves with more people in need. We currently can only serve each family once every three months and we can only provide \$20-\$50, depending on the number of people in the household. We are currently serving over 100 families each month. Our last St Vincent de Paul second collection was \$6064.61.

In Matthew 19:21, Jesus told a rich young man to sell all his possessions and give the money to the poor, speaking directly to the principle of detachment from earthly possessions for the sake of following Jesus. I was moved by this passage and praying with the Lord, I reflected on why I have so many possessions that I do not use, sitting around my home and my garage. I also noticed that managing all these possessions, took time away from my day, which could better be used in prayer or giving my time and talent to others that may need it.

Last week I rummaged my home, looking for everything I did not use and organized a garage sale following the words of the Lord in Matthew 19:21 where I vowed to the Lord that the earnings of this sale would go to the ministry of St Vincent de Paul. I not only donated \$700, but provided goods to the less fortunate that did not have the money to pay for what they needed.

As a fellow parishioner and a new member of the St Vincent de Paul ministry, I am asking that you my brothers and sisters, also take that same moment to reflect on what you can sell and give to this ministry. We have many people in need and your possessions are only the ones that have been given to you by the Lord, and belong to him alone.

If you are moved to donate to St Vincent de Paul we have various second collections throughout the year or you can drop a donation off at the rectory marked for St Vincent de Paul. Thank you for your generosity!
