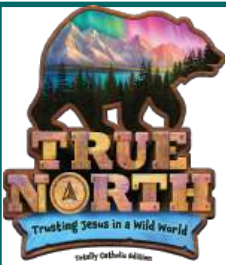
FAITH FORMATION
