FR.TK.REFLECTIONS 20th SUNDAY YEAR -C- 2025:

THE DIVISIVE PRINCE OF PEACE:

Did he come to bring peace or division? is he still prince of peace after these words in the gospel today(Lk12:49-53) I have come to bring fire on the earth and how I wish it were already kindled(49), this statement alone would have landed Jesus into prison for several year in the State of California because of talking of fire. He would have been accused of being arsonist and premeditated malicious damage of properties. Did he come to bring **peace of division?** Why is he wishing such disruption within the families? Jesus for sure is very practical in the human sense of family and community especially in our current set up of the society. The divisions on political affiliations, religion, and tribal background, are these not leaving a divided family and society? How many people in a family can't see eye to eye due to politics, material possession which is creating a lot of egoism and hatred leading to wars and a lot of sufferings. is this not what the Lord is talking about? How many priests can't see eye to hear with one another due to the different approach of life especially political. The fact that you support a different person you divide the parish, JUMUIYA and even the families!

Jesus from the very beginning has been full, of contradiction, in the presentation. the old folk Simon attested that **see him, he will be for the rise and fall of many In Israel, he shall stand as a sign of contradiction, while a sword will pierce your soul** (Lk.2:35) The coming of Christ brought **sorrow and joy.** His message definitely will divide the families, communities even the churches over the issue of

this prince of peace. The church is already divided in many issues and opinions like, doctrinal, administrative, charismatic, prolife, visionaries, same sex marriage issue, are these not tearing the Catholic Church into pieces?
