FR.TK.REFLECTIONS 24th SUNDAY YEAR-C-2025:

THE GREAT SEARCH-LOST AND FOUND:

This is the 24th Sunday of the year .we have only 10 more Sundays to go and we have another season of the Liturgical year.what a Sunday to reflect on where we are coming from,where we are and map,out which direction do we take from here. Is there, anything we need to improve, to get rid off or retain in our spiritual way? Our readings call us look into our self, search, locate where we are and see anything which demands our attention that we may go back to our loving Merciful God

In the gospel(Lk.15:1-10)The scribes and Pharisees are shocked by Christ on what he is doing, something out of their unexpectations, eating and dinning with sinners. This is unheard of by these orthodoxy proclaimed, custodians of laws and the cream of the society. Sinners must be condemned according to them, on the contrary Jesus loved sinners and calls them to repentance.

This demonstrated by his behavior by giving these three episodes.
