




This Weekend's Second Collection is for Bless the Children (CCD), No Second Collection Next Weekend.





END OF THE YEAR A TIME OF GIVING





WOMEN'S GUILD ANNUAL MASS & BRUNCH SUNDAY, JANUARY 11, 2026
