

FR.TK.REFLECTIONS SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT 2026:

TRANSIFIGURATION:

Last week our gospel spoke about the **desert** where Jesus spend 40 days.We could classify it as **the call to desert experience**.It was the call of **prayer,fasting and almsgiving** these are our tools for Lenten welfare.
