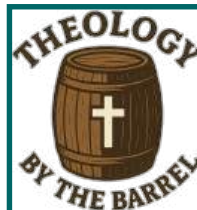


Do you have any extra rosaries at home?

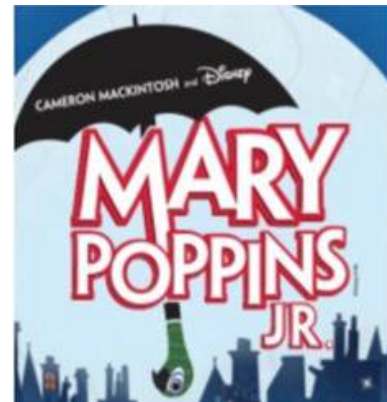
ST. A'S SCHOOL

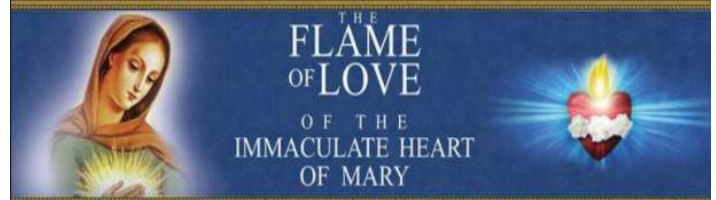
