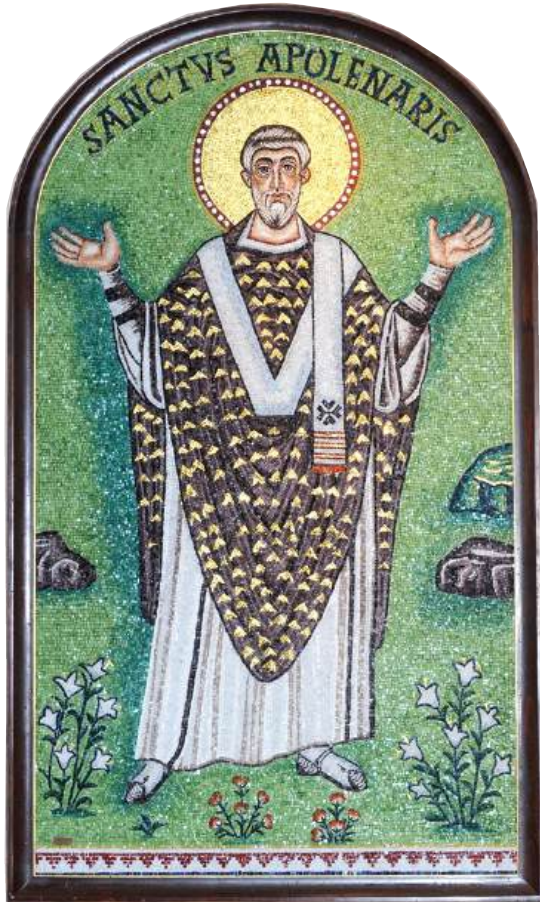

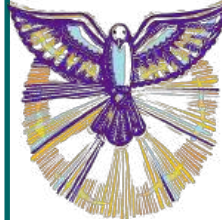
First Holy Communion Preparation

Our two year First Holy Communion program is for children who are in at least 1st grade. Preparation lasts two years and children receive the sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion during the second year of the program.

Preparation requires attendance for two (2) consecutive years to receive sacraments.

Confirmation Class



Our St. Apollinaris Religious Education Confirmation Program provides Preparation for the sacrament of Confirmation.

Confirmation Preparation

Our two year Confirmation program is for baptized children who are in at least 6th grade. Preparation for Confirmation lasts two years and children receive the sacrament of Confirmation in the second year of the program. Anyone 18 and up enrolls in our St. Apollinaris Adult Confirmation program.

Preparation classes require attendance for two (2) consecutive years to receive sacraments.

Registration will open to new incoming families August 1st. Please watch for the electronic registration link in the bulletin this summer.

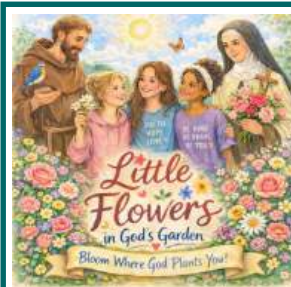
