designed to support the parents of baptized children who are not attending Catholic school (or who are new to Catholic school and in need of classes for Sacramental Preparation).

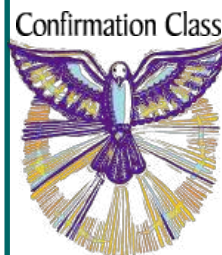
First Holy Communion Preparation

Reflections on the Sixth World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly by Deacon Max Schellman

Each year, on the fourth Sunday in July, we celebrate the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. Introduced by Pope Francis in 2021, this special day falls near the memorial of Saints Anne and Joachim, parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary and Jesus' maternal grandparents. It is a wonderful opportunity to reflect on the closeness and interdependence we all share as a community. We are reminded to cherish the wisdom and experience of our grandparents and elders, who generously pass on life lessons and the message of the Gospel for the good of society.

This year, Pope Leo chose "I will never forget you" as the theme. Drawn from the Book of the Prophet Isaiah (Is 49:15), this message offers hope and peace not only to grandparents and the elderly, but to all of us. It is a loving reminder to remember and honor the seniors in our lives—both living and deceased—and to recognize the many blessings they have been and continue to be for us. Grandparents often embody hope and peace through the wisdom and insights gained from their life journeys. They have weathered many storms, witnessing firsthand the ebb and flow of life's challenges. Their resilience stands as a testament to the enduring power of hope, showing younger generations the value of remaining steadfast in faith that brighter days are ahead.

As custodians of family traditions and values, and as repositories of knowledge, grandparents impart invaluable lessons about hope as a cornerstone of endurance and faith. As both a grandparent and a senior, I recall with gratitude the many ways my grandparents and other elders have shown me examples of hard work, compassion, selflessness, integrity, and countless acts of love, care, and generosity. I am often reminded that they, along with my parents, were fundamental in shaping who I am today. Now, we, especially we seniors, have a special responsibility to the generations that follow—to embrace them with love, compassion, and wisdom, just as we have received from those before us.

This year's theme also emphasizes the unfailing love God has for each person. I recite a prayer penned by St. Francis de Sales every morning, which beautifully expresses God's constant care:

"Do not look forward in fear to the changes in life; rather, look to them with full hope that as they arise, God, whose very own you are, will lead you safely through all things. And when you cannot stand it, God will take care of you—then and every day. Do not fear what may happen tomorrow; the same understanding Father who cares for you today will take care of you then and every day. He will either shield you from suffering or will give you unfailing strength to bear it. Be at peace and put aside all anxious thoughts and imaginations."

Celebrating grandparents and the elderly honors their contributions and highlights the enduring legacy of hope they pass down through the generations. Their stories, advice, and unconditional love remind us to be confident in God's love.
