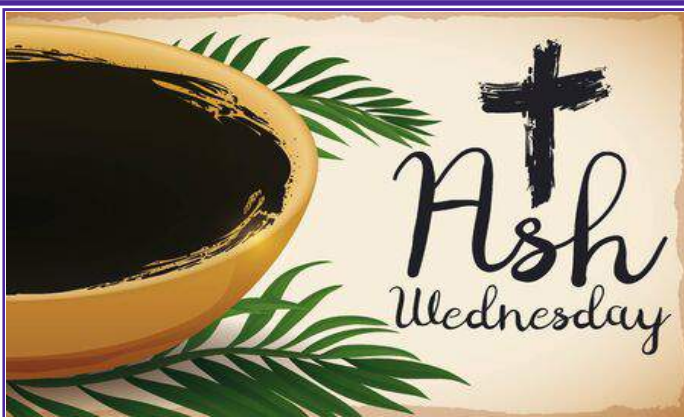

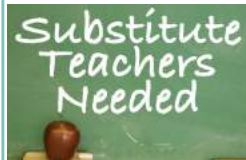
Our Mission
